ICM FCM 36 Light Tank

I called into Constellation Hobbies over the break and noticed that they had imported a few ICM kits, this FCM 36 being one that caught my eye. I have always thought that this is an attractive subject because of it's futuristic shape which reminds me of a Dalek and also the exotic colour schemes it was delivered in are nice. The FCM 36 is equivalent to the Renault R35 in terms of design requirements and usage, i.e. it was meant to be an updated take on the WW 1 FT-17, a 2 man infantry tank. FCM did not have access to the large casting capabilities that some of the other French manufacturers like Renault and Hotchkiss and so they opted to produced a welded steel design with well sloped plates that offered increased protection while adding little extra weight. This design was produced before the Russians adopted the same idea for their legendary T-34.


In combat, the FCM 36 was not a great success as strategy and tactics had moved on and the German Blitzkrieg swept through France. In tank vs tank fighting the armour proved to be a success but the puny 37mm low velocity cannon was ineffective against the German tanks even though their armour was not overly thick at that point of the war. The Germans subsequently repurposed the FCM 35 as part of the Becker conversion program and like many other French tanks, it became the basis for an expedient tack destroyer mounting the famous 75mm Pak 40 anti tank gun.


ICM are the first and so far only manufacturer to release this unusual tank in plastic and I commend them on producing a kit of such an interesting subject such as this along with some of the other French WW2 subjects that other manufacturers have not bothered to touch. The kit has now been issued in several releases but essentially the parts are identical.

The kit is fairly conventional in it's parts layout insofar as the unconventional hull design allows. As is normal today there is no evidence of flash. The plastic is on the medium soft side and should not cause too many headaches. There are a number of very small parts which will require careful removal and cleanup, not to mention protection from the dreaded carpet monster. The kit does not rely on alignment pins and has a number of butt joints which will require extra care when assembling. Very little internal detail is provided for those wishing to model open hatches, ICM supply a combination canon/machine gun mount and some details for the inside of the turret hatch. There are 3 individual sprues with the one carrying the suspension and other details being duplicated.

The kit comes with old style flexible tracks which are made up of 2 lengths per side. The FCM 36's track design is not overly complex and a lot of their length is effectively hidden from view so the vinyl tracks look ok. The FCM 36 has a suspension that looks very much like a shrunken version of the British Matilda tank's. with a 4 small bogies each mounting 4 small steel wheels. ICM have supplied 2 sprues of chain links which get clipped together through a slit in every second link which looks a little tedious to assemble but will certainly loot the part when done.

The kit is rounded out with a small decal sheet covering 2 quite different schemes the first, shown on the box art is a 2 tone green over sand pattern while the second option is for a more complex multicolored scheme which is similar to a vehicle that is now preserved in the French tank museum at Saumur.






Read the instructions thoroughly prior to assembly. Each component is numbered. Adhere to specified sequence of assembly. Tools required: kinife and file for removal of components from frame; rubber bond, adhersive appear and colors pegs for clamping components together after applying adhesive. Clean plastic components in a mild detergent solution and allow to air-dry so that paint and transfers adhere better. Prior to applying adhesive, clean clean the components fit together; apply adhesive sparingly, Remove chrome and paint from the contact surfaces. Paint small components before removing them from the frame. Allow paint to dry well, and only then continue to assemble. Cut out each transfer individually and immerse in warm water for approx. 20 seconds. Slide transfer off paper and into designated position, then press on with biotting paper.

their original Anson!)






























ICM Mitsubishi Ki-21lb "Sally" Announcement



ICM have announced the release in Quarter 4 of 2022 of both a 1/72 and 1/48 (If it is in both scales in unconfirmed but likely_) Bomber. (the type used at Kalkin-Gol in 1939) but it is sure to be part of a family of Ki -21s.
