A major prize of \$100 is on offer for the winner of the Trifecta, the modeller who has built the best 3 models in the BSK competition. One model must be from each category.













# RNZAF F4U-1D & FG-1D Corsairs


1/32 V3282

The latest decal sheet in 1:32 scale from Malcolm Laird at VENTURA covers two RNZAF Corsairs, one an Island's based F4U-1D NZ5485 (Kohimarama IX) of No.5 SU/23 Squadron Los Negros late 1945, and a No.14 Squadron FG-1D NZ5617 (Verna) based at Iwakuni in Japan in 1946.

### FG-1D Corsair NZ561 "Verna"

FG-1D Corsair NZ5617 with No.14 Squadron, RNZAF, Japan, 1946. NZ5617 is in the US Navy all-over Glossy Sea Blue scheme with 48 inch roundels on the wings and 36 inch on the fuselage sides. This decal sheet does not include these roundels. Propeller blades are black with yellow-orange tips. Spinner is also yellow-orange.




# **RNZAF F4U-1D & FG-1D Corsairs** 1/32 V3282

The sheet only contains the roundels for NZ5485 (those for NZ5617 will have to be found in the decal bank, or painted on using masks) but has all the other markings required for both aircraft other than the maintenance stencilling. The type stencilling and the Bu. Air numbers for both are included for the fin and rudder.

Ventura has printed the roundels in what I consider to be an accurate representation of the wartime operational blue, and in a very clever move, the borders for the roundel white bars have been printed in the same blue as the roundel.

As the RNZAF applied roundels on the starboard upper wing, and the port underside did not usually have the Insignia Blue borders of the overpainted US ones on the port upper, the starboard lower, and the fuselage, there is a second small sheet supplied with the insignia Blue borders that can be added where needed!

# **RNZAF F4U-1D & FG-1D Corsairs** 1/32 V3282

Both style of roundel are supplied, the 'offset' for the overpainted US ones, and the 'parallel' ones for the additions. The instructions make this very clear as to where they are to be applied.

The one thing missing from both the artwork, and the instructions, is that the Japan bound FG-1D's of No.14 Squadron had their original 'Pacific' white barred roundels completely overpainted with a roughly applied coat of what appears to be Ns.Sea Blue before the addition of the post war type roundels.

This remained in evidence in all photos of No.14's Corsairs until the survivors were burnt at Bofu! By using black serials from the decal stash, NZ5617 can be built in its earlier appearance, without the white 17 on the fin. I have a very personal connection with this aircraft, as it was my late fathers 'charge' with No.14 Squadron in Japan, and was named after his then fiancé, soon to be his wife and my mum.

The other problem is that as yet, we don't have an accurate kit of the F4U-1D/FG-1D in 1:32! I'm sure Tamiya will be releasing one eventually if they follow their release pattern with the 1:48 scale kits......

The roundels CAN be used with the F4U-1A kits to build a Kiwi operational Corsair, but serials and such will have to be added from ones decal bank.

Overall, a great and accurate addition to ones RNZAF decals. Nice one Ventura...


